Please note:

- Non-diploma exams run on January 13 - 27. Non-Diploma exams will be written in various locations throughout this time. Locations for exams will be posted in the main Foyer.
- Students are expected to write their exams on the expected date and time. Any unique/extraordinary circumstances need to be appealed to the exam coordinator, Assistant Principal, Beverly Delion as soon as possible.
- Science 14, Science 24, Math 10-3, Math 20-3, Math 30-3 non-diploma exams will be written in class, before January 17.
- Credit recovery is an opportunity for students or teachers to request additional time to focus on course completion.
- On Demand Day – students who have missing assignments or assessments will be requested by their teachers to attend school to work on incomplete course work.

Student Expectations:

- To arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the exam
- To show valid photo identification (student ID card, driver’s license, passport) to enter the exam writing space
- To come prepared with the necessary writing materials (e.g. pencil, eraser, highlighter, pen, approved calculator, water bottle, snacks)
- To return textbooks prior to each exam
- Coats, hats, backpacks are not permitted in the exam room. Students should leave these items in their locker or vehicle.
- Cellphones, watches, ear buds or electronic devices are not permitted in the exam room. Students should leave these items in their locker or vehicle.
